Objective of the Program	To foster Early Clinical Exposure and seamlessly bridge basic medical sciences with clinical applications, showcasing a union of academia and artistry.



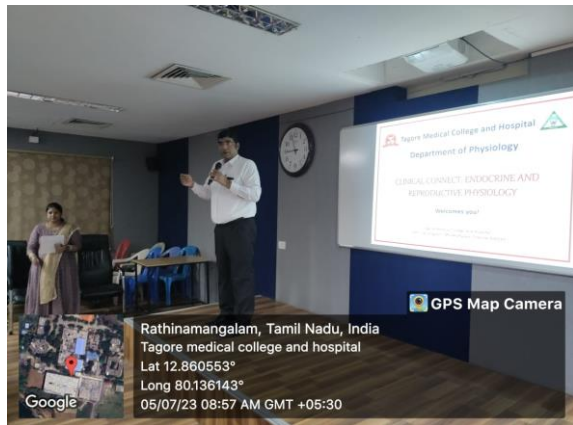
Detailed report of the program

Clinical connect is an event organised by the department of physiology, Tagore Medical College and Hospital. It is a union of academics and art where students incorporate physiology into creative channels such as poetry, short stories, tableaux and rangoli. The event started in lecture hall 1 with a welcome address by Dr. Deepika from the department of physiology. There were 8 events in total including 4 on day events and 4 pre-events. Poetry, digital art, mnemonics and short story were pre-events. Poetry was conducted the day before 4/07/23 in the department of physiology. There were 13 participants who assembled in the lab to write poems on topics of their own choosing from Reproductive and Endocrine physiology. Poems on topics like infertility were written. It was judged by Dr. Manikandan, professor, department of physiology who spoke about the thoughtful poems after the welcome speech. Digital art had 21 teams and 2 individual participants and was judged by Dr. Shidenkumar, tutor, dept of physiology. The participants sent their artwork the day prior online. All the artwork was showcased on the day of the event. Mnemonics had 20 participants and these were also sent online the day prior. They were showcased on the day of the event. This event was judged by Dr. Subhithsha, tutor from the department of physiology. Short story was conducted in a similar fashion and had 13 participants. It was judged by Dr. Suba Malani. She spoke about the creative short stories written on topics like diabetes mellitus. Then, after a short break we moved on to the main events of the day. The first event was tableaux. There were 3 teams who gave performances on tetany, grave's disease and cushing's syndrome. Tableaux was judged by the Head of department of physiology, Dr. Navin Rajaratnam. After tableaux, the other 3 events, Oral presentation, Rangoli and Poster making were conducted simultaneously. Oral presentation was conducted in 4 halls simultaneously and had 28 participants in total. The participants were allotted topics via lot system and prepared 6-minute-long presentations. The presentations were judged on layout, explanation and timing. The judges were Dr. Manikandan, Dr. Deepika, Tutor, Dept of physiology, Dr. Rupashree, and Dr. Suba malani, associate professor, dept of physiology in hall 1, 2, 3 and 4 respectively. Rangoli was conducted in the auditorium and had 11 teams. All the teams made beautiful rangolis on topics like ovulation and spermatogenesis. It was judged by Dr. Priscilla from the department of biochemistry. Poster making was also conducted in the auditorium and had 20 teams. Topics were allotted by lot system and the teams made colourful and informative posters. It was judged by Vice principal and head of department of Anatomy Dr. D.H Gopalan, Dr. Vani and Dr. Aswini

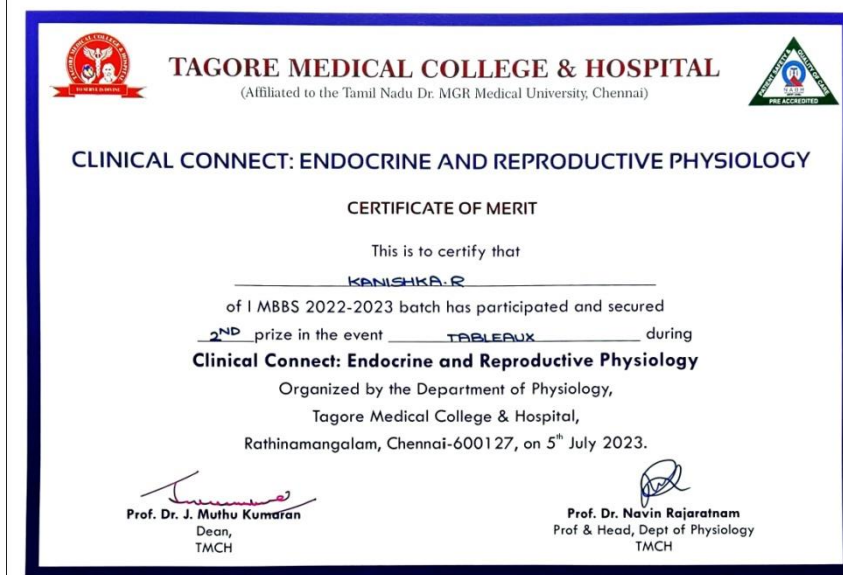

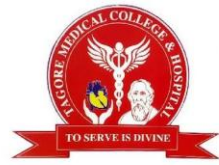
