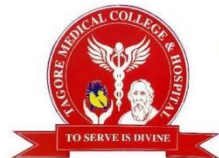

### Detailed report of the program

Clinical Connect 2025: Endocrine and Reproductive Physiology was organized by the Department of Physiology, Tagore Medical College and Hospital on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2025. This academic event was conducted to foster Early Clinical Exposure by connecting Basic Medical Sciences with clinical applications.

The event started in Lecture Hall 1 with a welcome address by Dr. S. Subhashri, Associate Professor, Department of Physiology. A total of 12 events were conducted, including 5 on-day events and 7 pre-events. Endocrine Quiz was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> June, in the lecture hall 1. A total of 17 teams, with 4 participants per team. The quiz was held in 6 round with a variety of questions asked in creative ways. The event was coordinated by the student Subakharani and organized by Dr. K. Deepika, Department of Physiology. Poetry was conducted on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2025 in the Demo room, Department of Physiology, and was coordinated by the student P. Lavanya and Judged by Dr. V. Vignesh, Tutor, Department of Physiology. There were 11 participants, who assembled in the demo hall to write poems on topics of their own choosing from Endocrine and Reproductive Physiology, in both English and Tamil.

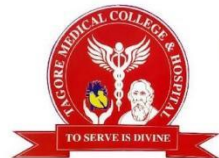

The Debate was held on 4<sup>th</sup> June, in the Lecture hall 1, and featured 2 teams with 5 participants per team. The topic of debate was “Hypothyroidism vs Hyperthyroidism: Which poses a greater health challenge?” the debate was thought provoking and was coordinated by the student S. Anand and Judged by Dr. S. Sowmiya and Dr. V. Vishnuvaradhan, Tutor, Department of Physiology

The event Tableaux was conducted on 4<sup>th</sup> June and was organized by the Student Harani Sri. There were 2 teams who gave performances on Diabetes mellitus and Osteoporosis. Tableaux was judged by Dr. S. Subhashri, Associate Professor, Department of Physiology,

On the day of the event, 5<sup>th</sup> June 2025, five events were held. The first event was Rangoli with 13 teams, each of whom brought out their creativity in the form of various designs under the topic Endocrine and Reproductive Physiology. This event was coordinated by the student Janane Shree and judged by Mrs. D.Saveetha, Tutor, Department of Anatomy. Following this three events, Oral Presentation, Clinical Case Presentation and Star Scientist were held simultaneously

Oral presentation was conducted in 2 halls simultaneously and had 14 participants in total, coordinated by the student Sam Richard and Judged by Dr. Muthuvel, Professor and Head, Department of Pathology and Dr. Meenakshi, Professor, Department of Biochemistry. Topics were allotted to the participants who prepared 6-minute-long presentations. These Presentations were judged on the basis of layout, explanation and



timing.

Clinical Case Discussion was conducted in 4 halls simultaneously and had 37 participants, who discussed the key signs and symptoms, diagnostic tests, treatment and overview about a disease which had been assigned to them priorly. The event was coordinated by the student Aleena Benoy and judged by Dr. Selvaraj, Professor, Department of Community Medicine, Dr. S. Subamalani, Professor, Department of Physiology, Dr. Shenbaga Lalitha, Associate Professor, Department of Biochemistry and Dr. K. Deepika, Assistant Professor, Department of Physiology. The participants were judged on the basis of coverage of topic, organization of ideas, layout, design and discussion.

Star Scientist was held in 1 hall and had 10 participants, with each participant delivering a speech on the life of scientists who played an important role in the discovery of various aspects of Endocrine Physiology. The event was coordinated by the student Shraya Venunath and judged by Dr. Chanemougavalli J, Assistant Professor, from the Department of Anatomy.

The final event Poster Presentation saw 37 teams with 3 participants each. Various creative posters were made on topics such as Hormonal mechanisms and Endocrine diseases. This event was Coordinated by Srevarsha Selvakumar. The winners were selected by a panel of judges comprising of Dr. K. Gunanithi, Professor and Head, Department of Biochemistry, Dr. Glory Josephine, Professor, Department of Pharmacology, Dr. Sony Paul, Professor, Department of Microbiology and Dr. C Swathi Priyadarshini, Assistant Professor, Department of Anatomy.

After all the competitions concluded, The event concluded with a Valedictory ceremony held in Lecture Hall 1. Dr. S. Subhashri, Associate Professor of Physiology, delivered the welcome address. Next, Dr. Navin Rajaratnam, Professor and Head of Physiology, addressed the gathering with his inspiring words. The Event report was delivered by Dr. Rewanth Naik, Tutor in Physiology. Dr. J. Muthukumar, Dean, TMCH, gave the keynote address, applauding the success of the event and encouraging future academic initiatives. The ceremony concluded with prize distribution to the winners, followed by the vote of thanks by Dr. K. Deepika, Assistant Professor of Physiology and the National Anthem.

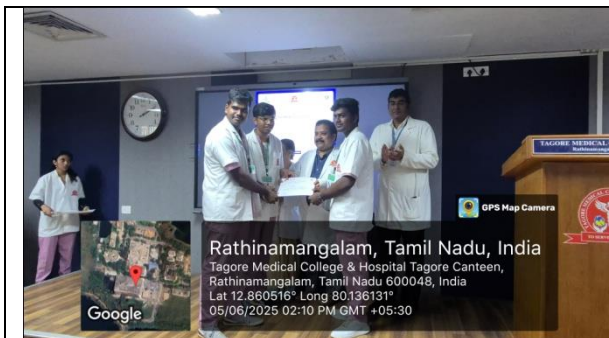

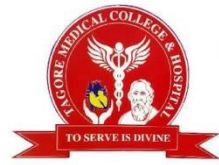

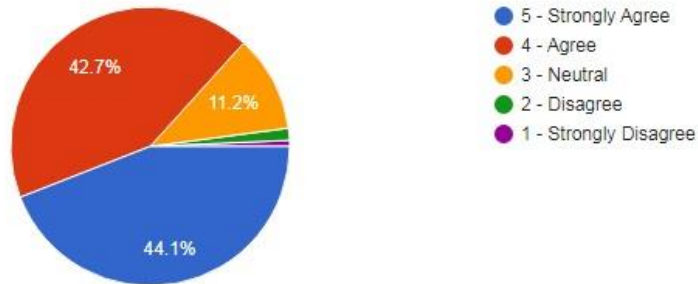

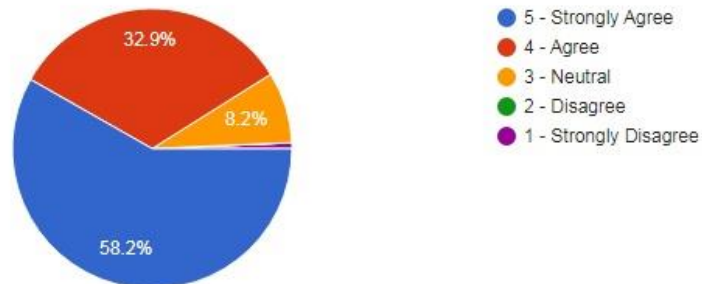

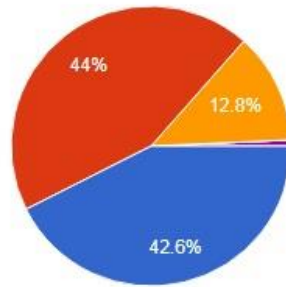

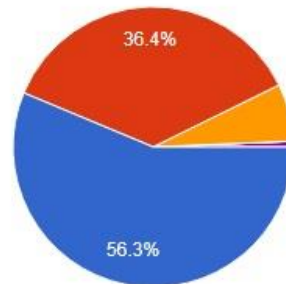

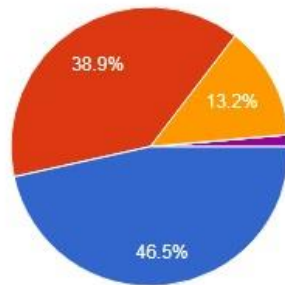

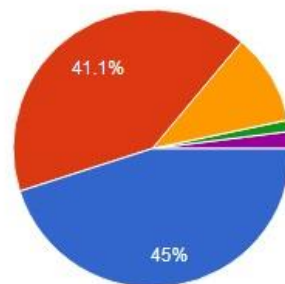

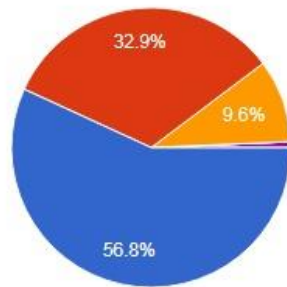
