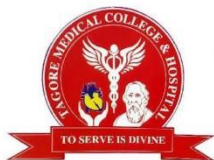

Detailed report of the program

Clinical Connect 2026: Endocrine and Reproductive Physiology was organized by the Department of Physiology, Tagore Medical College and Hospital on 4th June 2026. This academic event was conducted to foster Early Clinical Exposure by connecting Basic Medical Sciences with clinical applications.

The event started in Lecture Hall 1A with a welcome address by Dr. S. Subhashri, Associate Professor, Department of Physiology. A total of 12 events were conducted, including 5 on-day events and 6 pre-events. Digital art, Mnemonics and Animation making were pre-events conducted online while, Quiz and Poetry were pre-events held on-stage. The 7 on-day events were Debate, Rangoli, Clinical case Presentation, Oral



Presentation, Star Scientist, Tableaux and Poster Presentation.

Endocrine Quiz was held on 2nd June, in the lecture hall 3 with a total of 35 teams, with 4 participants per team. The quiz was held in 6 round with a variety of questions asked in creative ways. The event was coordinated by the student Shruti Balaji, Dinesh Munusamy and organized by Dr. K. Deepika Assistant Professor and Dr. Jamuna Devi, Tutor Department of Physiology. Poetry was conducted on 2nd June 2026 in the Demo room, Department of Physiology, and was coordinated by the student Shyam Sundhar, Shanamathi and Mr. Pavithran, Tutor, Physiology. The event was Judged by Dr. T. Kaviarasu, Tutor, Department of Physiology. There were 8 participants, who assembled in the demo hall to write poems on topics of their own choosing from Endocrine and Reproductive Physiology, in both English and Tamil.

Digital art had 75 participants in 25 teams. The event was Coordinated by the student Varshini S, Mugilan A and Dr. Jamuna Devi, Tutor, Physiology. The event was Judged by Dr. K. Deepika, Assistant Professor, Department of Physiology. The participants sent their artworks online, on a prior date. The best art works were showcased on the day of the event. Mnemonics making had 23 participants and these were also sent online, the day prior. They were showcased on the day of the event. This event was coordinated by the student Saadhanaa, John Caleb and Dr. Vinitha, Tutor, Physiology. The Event was Judged by Dr. S. Subhashri, Associate Professor, Department of Physiology.

The Debate was conducted as 2 rounds, Preliminary round was held on 1st June 2026, in the Lecture hall 3, and featured 4 teams with 4 participants per team. The topic of debate was "The Hypothalamus vs. Pituitary Gland: The Primary Driver of Hormonal Regulation?" Vs "The Role of the Thyroid Gland vs. Adrenal Glands in Metabolism: Which Takes Precedence?" and the final round was held on 4th June 2026, in the Lecture hall 1A, and featured 2 teams with 4 participants per team. The topic of debate was "Hypothyroidism vs Hyperthyroidism: Which poses a greater health challenge?" the debate was thought provoking and was coordinated by the student Monisha B, Evaneeth S and Dr. Vinitha, Tutor, Physiology. The Event was Judged by Dr. S. Subhashri, Associate Professor, and Dr. S. Subamalani, Professor, Department of Physiology.

On the day of the event, 4th June 2026, Seven events were held. The first event was Debate final. The next event was Tableaux. The event Tableaux was conducted on 4th June and was organized by the Student Charvvini SD, Kshetragyan PS and Mr. Pavithran, Tutor, Physiology. There were 3 teams who gave performances on Diabetes Mellitus, Calcium Homeostasis and PMOS. Tableaux was judged by Dr. Navin Rajaratnam, Professor and Head, and Dr. K. Deepika, Assistant Professor, Department of Physiology,

Rangoli with 18 teams, each of whom brought out their creativity in the form of various designs under the topic Endocrine and Reproductive Physiology. This event was coordinated by the student Sakthivel B, Prathanan S and Dr. Kaviarasu, Tutor, Physiology. The Event was judged by Dr. Meenakshi, Professor Department of Biochemistry and Dr. Malini, Assistant Professor, Department of Microbiology.

Following this three events, Oral Presentation, Clinical Case Presentation and Star Scientist were held simultaneously. Oral presentation was conducted in 2 halls simultaneously and had 14 participants in total, coordinated by the student Bala Sundari S, Varsha RS and Dr. Jamuna Devi, Tutor, Physiology. The event was Judged by Dr. Glory, Professor, Department of Pharmacology and Dr. Sony Paul, Professor, Department of Microbiology. Topics were allotted to the participants who prepared 6-minute-long presentations. These Presentations were judged on the basis of layout, explanation and timing.

Clinical Case Discussion was conducted in 3 halls simultaneously and had 24 participants, who discussed the key signs and symptoms, diagnostic tests, treatment and overview about a disease which had been assigned to them priorly. The event was coordinated by the student Farnaaz fathima and Dr. Vinitha, Tutor, Physiology. The Event was judged by Dr. Muthuvel, Professor and Head, Department of Pathology, Dr. Pillai Ravishankar, Professor, Department of Pathology, Dr. Sriarthi Resident Department of Community Medicine, The participants were judged on the basis of coverage of topic, organization of ideas, layout, design and discussion.

Star Scientist was held in 1 hall and had 6 participants, with each participant delivering a speech on the life of scientists who played an important role in the discovery of various aspects of Endocrine and Reproductive Physiology. The event was coordinated by the student Thayalan A, Pavanthi B and Dr. Kaviarasu, Tutor, Physiology. The Event was judged by Dr. Priyadharshini, Professor and Head, from the Department of Microbiology.

The final event Poster Presentation saw 39 teams with 3 participants each. Various creative posters were made on topics such as, Endocrine and Reproductive Physiology Hormonal mechanisms and Endocrine diseases. This event was Coordinated by Yuvaraj PD, Vasundira G and Mr. Pavithran, Tutor, Physiology. The winners were selected by a panel of judges comprising of Dr. Ramya, Professor, Department of Pharmacology, Dr. Bhuvaneshwari, Associate Professor, Department of Pharmacology, Dr. Femela, Professor, Department of Pathology and Dr. Savitha, Associate Professor, Department of Microbiology.

After all the competitions concluded, The event concluded with a Valedictory ceremony held in Lecture Hall 1A. Dr. S. Subhashri, Associate Professor of Physiology, delivered the welcome address. The ceremony concluded with prize distribution to the winners By the dignitaries Prof. Dr. Ravichandran Doraiswamy Dean, TMCH, Prof. Dr. T. Ravichandran, Medical Superintendent, TMCH, Prof. Dr. D.H. Gopalan, Vice Principal, TMCH, Dr. Navin Rajaratnam, Professor and Head of Physiology followed by the vote of thanks by Dr. Subamalani, Professor of Physiology and the National Anthem.

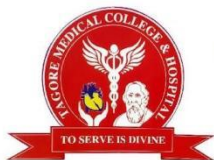

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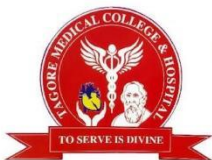
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Sample certificate of Event -Oral

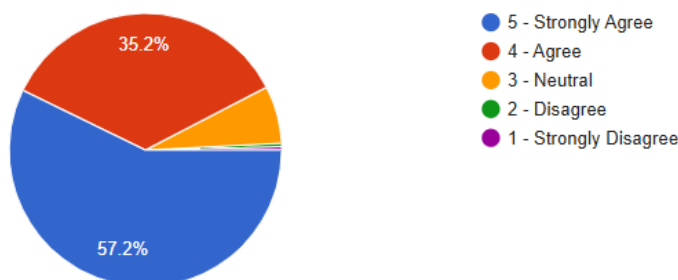

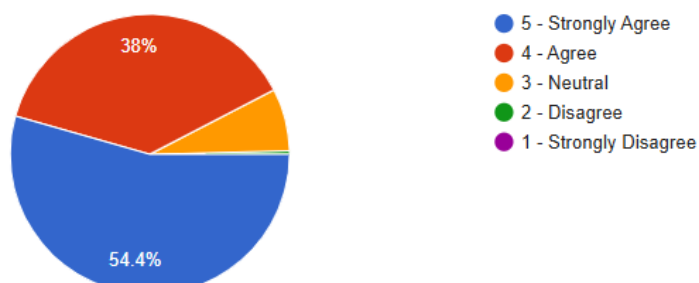

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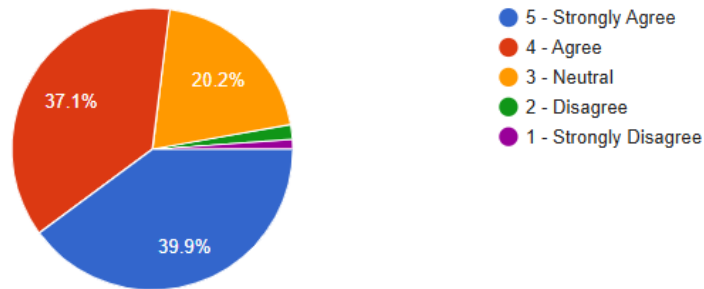


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The event - **Oral presentation** motivated me to pursue extra-learning and self-learning of physiology

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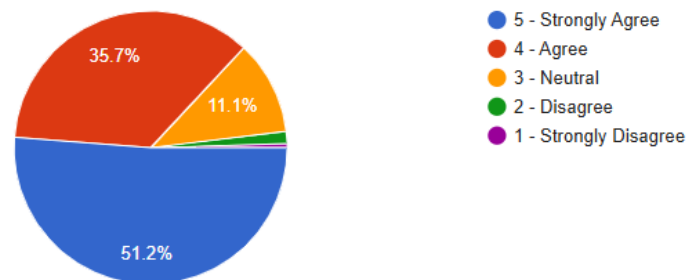

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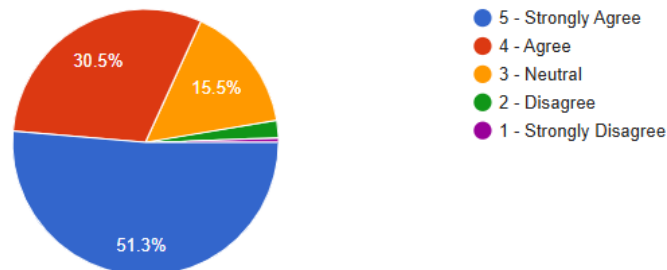

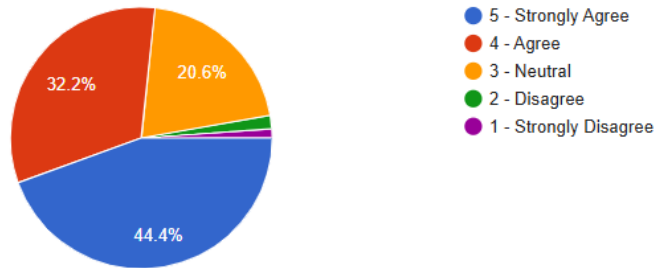

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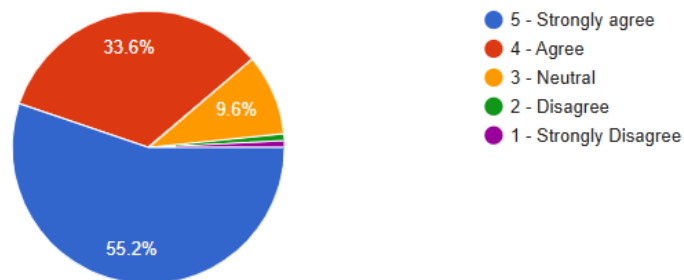

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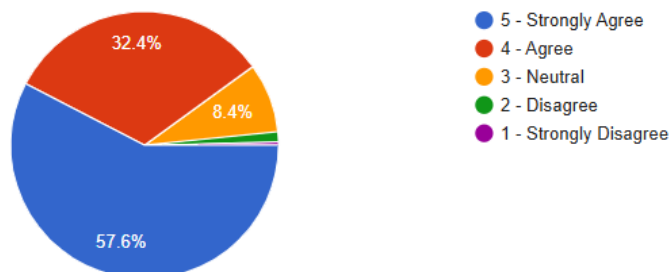

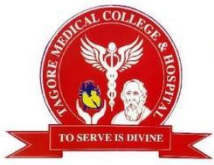

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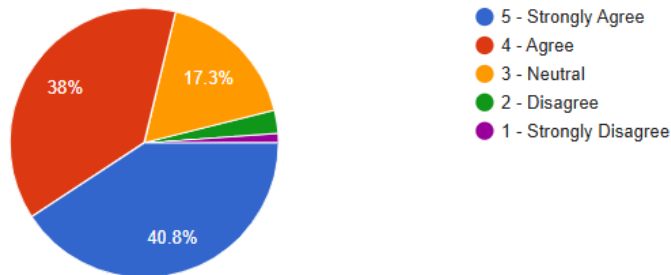

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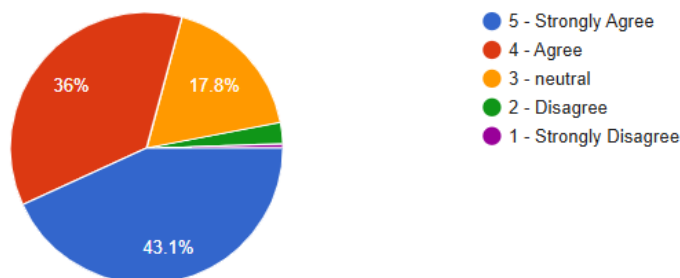

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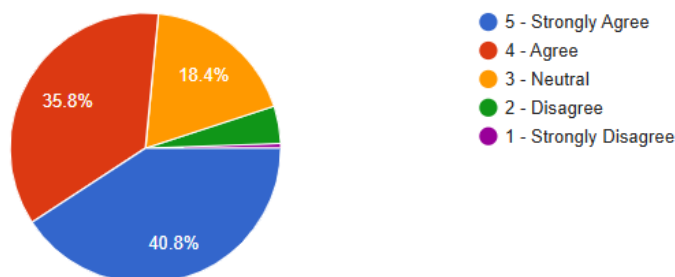

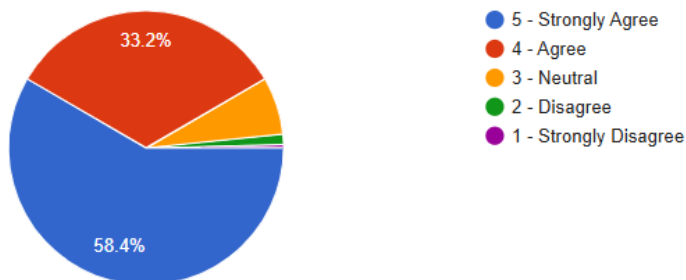


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The event - **Tableaux** motivated me to pursue extra-learning and self-learning of physiology

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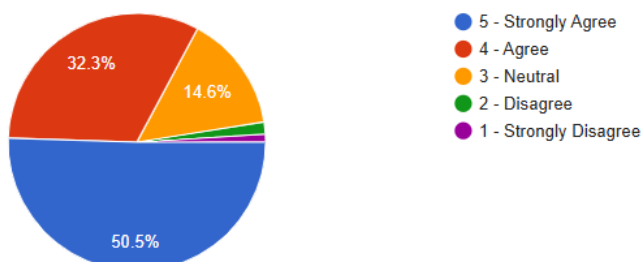

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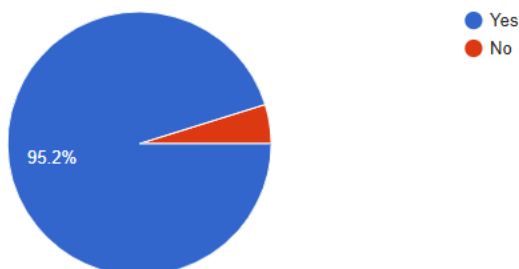

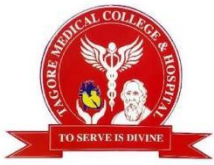
