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National Dengue Day 2026 Feedback Report

A feedback evaluation was conducted at the end of the National Dengue Day 2026 program to assess its effectiveness and overall impact. Feedback was obtained from 135 students using a semi-structured questionnaire that included both rating scales and open-ended responses. The feedback focused on the quality of sessions, relevance of topics, faculty effectiveness, learning environment, practical usefulness, and overall satisfaction with the program.

The average score for the presentations met the program objectives were 7 indicating that the sessions were useful and aligned with the objectives of the program. The average score for Quality of the speakers was 7 reflecting good appreciation for the speakers knowledge and presentation skills. The Practical value of the subject matter and the Value of the program in a public health setting also received an average score of 7 showing that participants found the sessions informative and relevant to public health practice.

POSITIVE FEEDBACK POINTS

The overall impression of the program received an average score of 7 indicating a high level of participant satisfaction. In the open-ended responses, students mentioned that the program was informative, interactive and helped them learn about dengue prevention and management. Participants appreciated the awareness created regarding vector control and community health measures.

SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT

Suggestions from students included allocating more time for the sessions and conducting additional competitions and interactive activities in future programs. Overall, the feedback indicates that the program was successful in improving awareness and knowledge regarding dengue prevention and public health importance.
