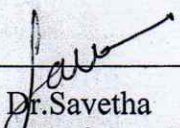
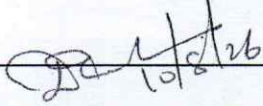
The resource person provided an insightful and comprehensive overview of vaccination strategies against hepatitis viruses, highlighting their importance in prevention and control.

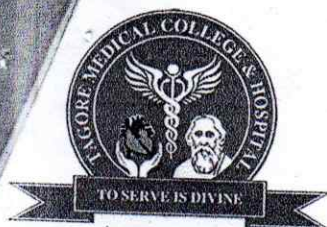

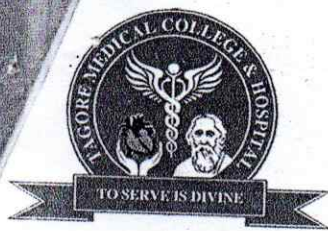
