16 September 2026

Sessions focused on the principles of pharmacovigilance, ADR identification, documentation, assessment, and reporting.



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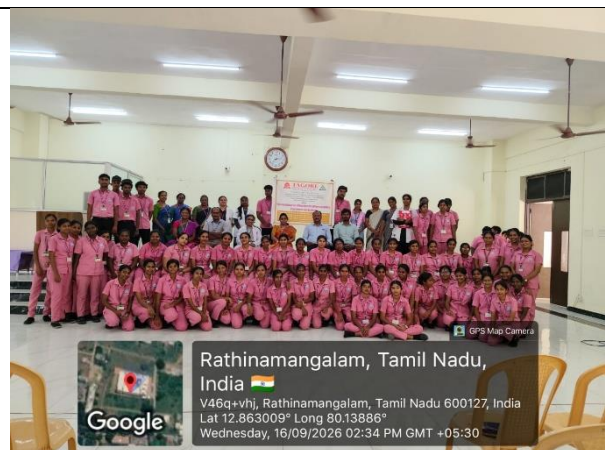


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Emphasis was placed on developing a strong culture of patient safety and rational medicine use among future healthcare professionals.

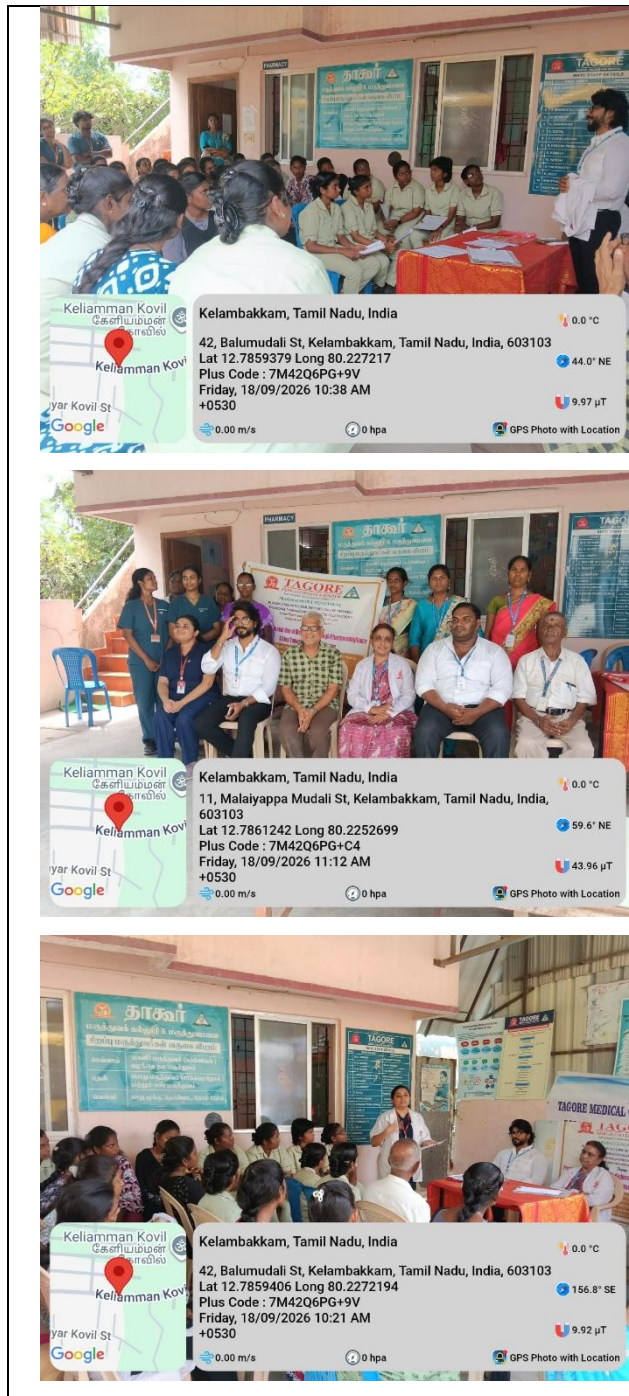

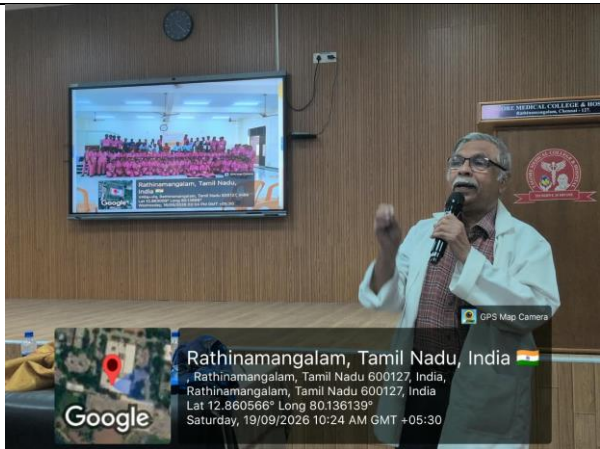
