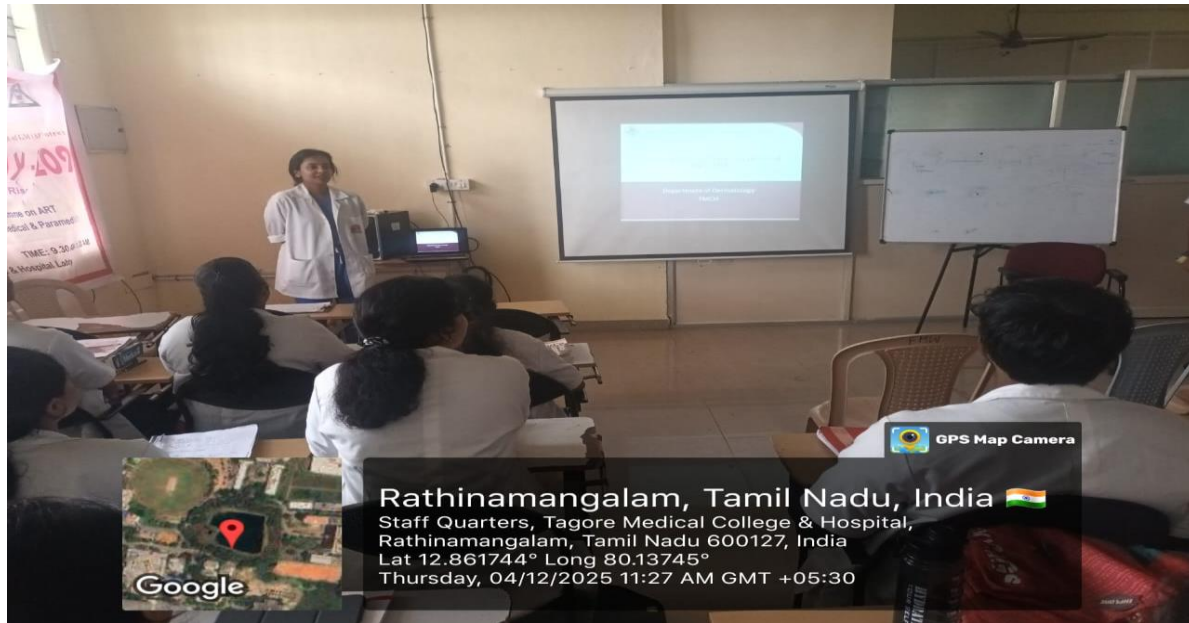
DAY-2 (04-12-2025)
