Detailed report of the program

The Department of Respiratory Medicine organized a workshop commemorating World TB Day 2024 at the Hospital Auditorium, 4th floor, on March 28, 2024, from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm. With 183 eager participants in attendance, the workshop promised to be a fruitful endeavor.
