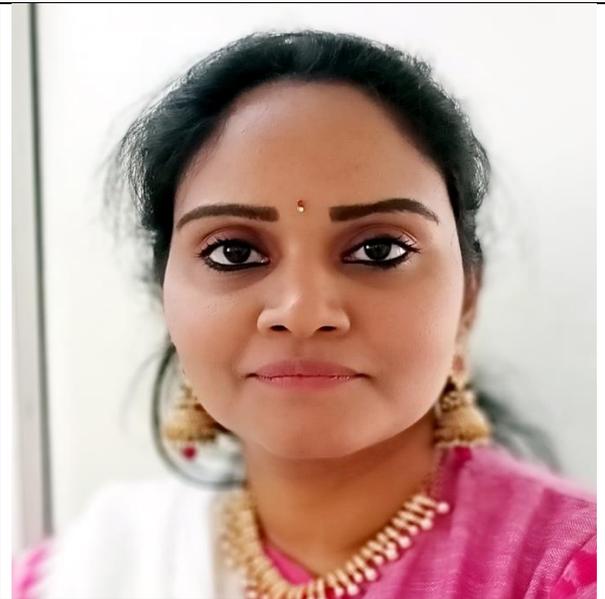


EHCF SCHOOL OF MEDICAL INFORMATICS -AWARD FOR BEST PAPER 2021
