Sub: Medical Education - Disaster Management Act, 2005 - COVID 19 – Lockdown extended in the territorial jurisdictions of the State of Tamil Nadu with existing guidelines and certain relaxation upto 06.00 AM of 23.08.2021 – Notification - Reopening of Medical and Dental Colleges in Tamil Nadu – Instructions issued -Regarding.

A copy of the Government Order in the reference cited is enclosed herewith for information and necessary action.

The Deans are informed that the Government have issued notification stating that, Medical, Dental and Para Medical Colleges are to function from 16.08.2021 onwards.

- ❖ The Deans are instructed to follow the Guidelines of the National Medical commission which was already communicated along with the Circular in the reference 1st cited.
- Classrooms, Libraries, Laboratories, Hostel Mess, Hostel, College and Hospital Premises have to be adequately Disinfected as per the Standard Protocol.
- Hand washing Stations with Liquid Soap and Sanitizer Dispensers wherever necessary are to be made available within the College, Hostel and Hospital Premises
- ❖ At the time of reporting to college, Students should submit their Status RT -PCR Report which should have been taken not more than 48 hours prior to joining
- Students who couldn't get the swab test done already can also get their RT-PCR tests done at their respective Institutions. Only after ensuring negative RT PCR, they should be permitted to attend classes and stay in Hostel.
- ❖ If any student is found to be symptomatic, he/she will have to be quarantined and treated as per Standard Protocol in their respective Medical College Hospitals.

- Theory and Practical Classes have to be scheduled in Small Batches so as to maintain social distancing.
- Thermal Screening of Students has to be performed daily at the College and Hostel Premises.
- Face Masks should be provided to the Students by the Institutions. Wearing of Face Mask is to be made compulsory at all times inside the College Premises
- All activities especially Sports and Cultural Functions which may lead to overcrowding has to be strictly avoided in the College campus. Hospital Premises, Hostel and Mess.
- A Special Health Monitoring Committee for the Supervision & Implementation of Preventive measures comprising Dean, Vice Principal, Resident Medical Officer and Hostel Warden has to be constituted.
- Social Distancing has to be strictly followed by the students in the Classrooms, Laboratories, Library, Mess and the Hostel Premises.
- Action Taken report has to be sent to this Office at the earliest.
