Objectives of NSS:

The NSS aims at developing the following qualities or competencies among the student volunteers:

- To understand the community in which they work
- To understand themselves in relation to their community
- To identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problemsolving
- To develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility
- To utilise their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems
- To develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities
- To gain skills in mobilising community participation
- To acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes
- To develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters and
- To practise national integration and social harmony

The NSS unit of Tagore Medical College and Hospital was established in 2023. Currently, there are two units under NSS with each unit comprising of 50 students. A total of 100 students are enrolled in the TMCH NSS.
