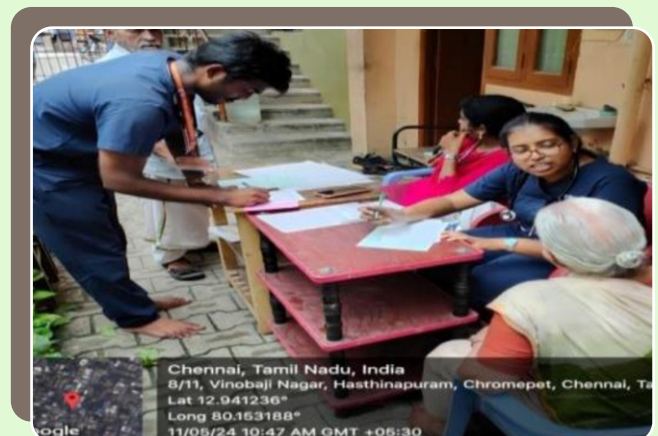

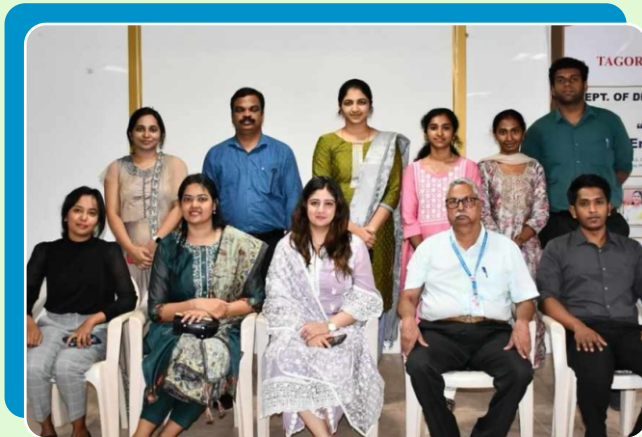

03-06-2024

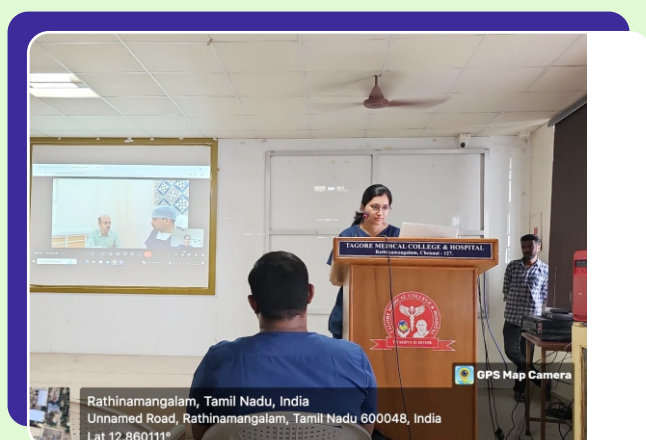

24-05-2024



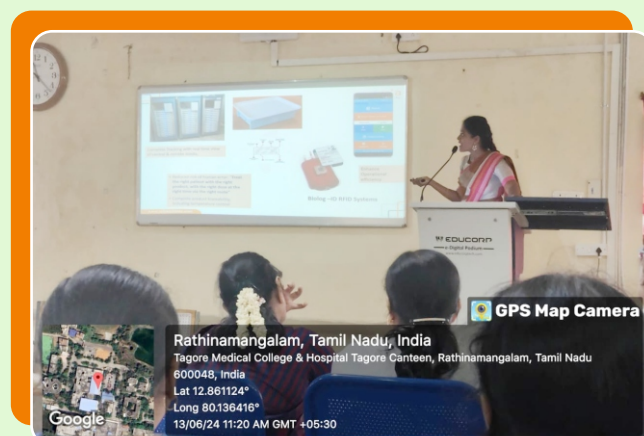

10th - 16th March 2024

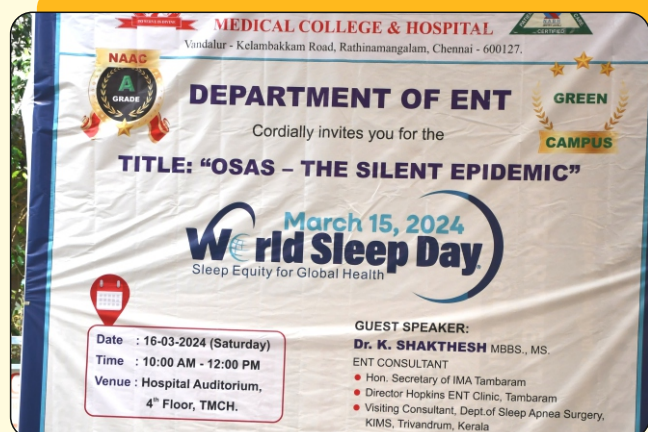

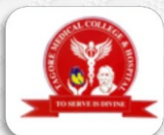
CO-PO MAPPING & ATTAINMENT WORKSHOP

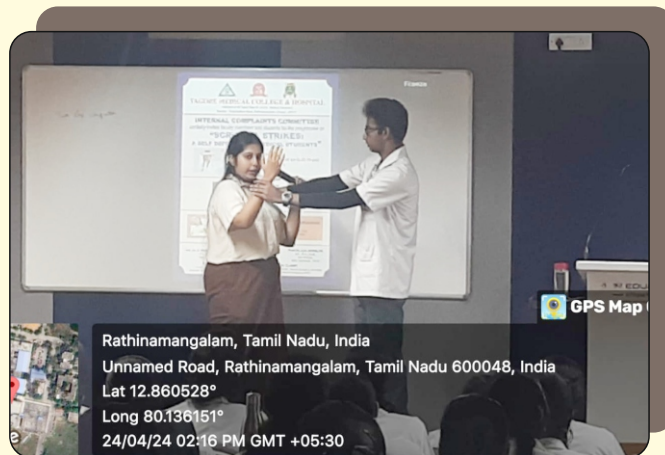
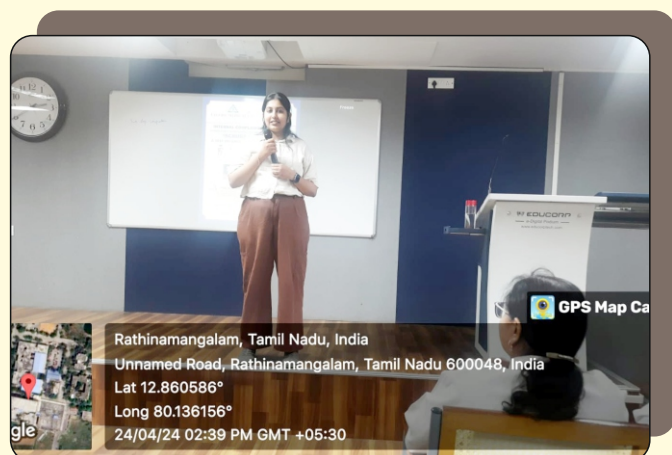
