A case of Klippel Feil syndrome

DR.HARI KRISHNAN S GENERAL MEDICINE PG
GUIDE – PROF DR.NASREEN

52 Year old male with no known comorbidities came with C/O difficulty in walking, restriction of neck movements, and hard of hearing since childhood.

Clinical and radiological findings: Abnormal vertebral segmentation and fusion, C2 – C3 vertebral fusion, low posterior hairline, restriction of neck movements, congenital torticollis, hearing impairment, Sprengel deformity.

DIAGNOSIS: Klippel Feil syndrome

• failure in the normal segmentation of cervical vertebra during early weeks of fetal development.

Mutation in GDF6 or GDF3 gene (growth derivation factor) as these genes make proteins that are involved in bone development and segmentation of vertebra

• Treatment- symptomatic: Physiotherapy, Genetic counselling and surgery may be required to relieve cervical instability or constriction of spinal cord.

A case of Goldenhar syndrome

75 year old male was admitted with clinical findings of Microtia, prominent nasal dorsum, malocclusion of teeth, maxillary hypoplasia, mandibular hypoplasia, muscles of mastication-hypoplastic unilateral, C2-C3 fusion of vertebra, facial asymmetry.

DIAGNOSIS: Goldenhar syndrome

• Treatment:

Symptomatic: Physiotherapy, Genetic counseling if unmarried, surgery may be required to relieve cervical instability or constriction of spinal cord.



A case of Malignant Mixed Mullerian tumor

A 32 year old female, nulligravida, married since one year with her LMP on 18.06.22 presented with c/o Heavy Menstrual Bleeding & Abdominal Distension the past 15 days. HMB present for the past 6 months which got aggravated in the last cycle, 15/18 cycle associated with clots.

Patient also complained of abdominal distension which was generalized in nature. Patient complains of reduced urine output and swelling of legs for the past 2 weeks. On Per Abdomen examination, Abdomen was distended, umbilicus in midline and everted. Skin appears stretched and shiny.

• Mass is Hard in consistency, ill defined margin, irregular surface, felt up to umbilicus, lower margins are not felt and Mobility restricted.


• Fluid thrill ++ and Shifting dullness ++.

CA 125 (Ovarian cancer marker) – 116.90 U/ml. (Normal Reference value <35 U/ml).

Endometrial Sampling: Impression – Features of Malignant Mixed Mullerian Tumor.

THE PATIENT WAS DIAGNOSED WITH

- Malignant Mixed Mullerian tumor of Endometrium with B/L adnexal and peritoneal involvement (or)
- synchronous serous adenocarcinoma of Endometrium and MMT Ovary with peritoneal and nodal metastasis.

A case of Currarino syndrome

A 23 year old male who is a veterinary doctor by occupation presented with

Chief complaints of low back pain for 5 years.

The patient was apparently normal 5 years ago after which he developed back pain insidious in onset, gradually progressive in nature, dull aching type, aggravated when standing for long time, partially relieved by medication .

To evaluate chronic back pain MRI LS spine was done which showed Hemi sacrum Presacral mass, Urinary bladder showed trabeculation.

X-ray of the Pelvis shows left sacral bony defect- Scimitar Sacrum

DIAGNOSIS: Currarino syndrome

Decision on Treatment depends on symptoms and radiological findings.



A case of MAYER-ROKITANSKY-KÜSTER-HAUSER (MRKH) SYNDROME

DR PREETHI K , GUIDE: DR SORNAM

15 year old girl who is a monozygotic twin came to the OPD with complaints of Primary amenorrhea. On examination

Breast development – Tanner stage 4

External hair – tanner stage 4

A vaginal dimple measuring 1-2 cm seen.

On Per Rectal examination a uterine nodule measuring 1-2 cm felt.

Her twin attained secondary sexual characters and menarche 2 years back.

On MRI – A uterine nodule measuring 1.1 x 0.5 cm is seen. Cervix and upper vagina not seen. A rudimentary lower vagina measuring 1.8 x 1.09 cm

The patient was diagnosed with Mullerian agenesis class I in a discordant monozygotic twin.

The patient was advised surgery to create a neovagina to provide sexual function and surrogacy for reproductive function.

A case of Unstable ankle fracture

DR CHEZIYAN,

28 YR old male had a history of high velocity trauma and sustained injury to his ankle.

O/E: Abrasion of size 6*5 cm over anterior aspect of rt ankle joint, diffuse swelling over right ankle joint, capillary refill time <2 sec, distal pulse present.

No distal neurovascular deficit

DIAGNOSIS: Unstable ankle fracture


Treatment

Stage 1 – Ankle spanning external fixator applied for 1 week

Stage 2 – ORIF with plating for fibula

CCS screw for medial and posterior malleoli



58/M; farmer from Chengalpattu; non-Smoker & no comorbidities came with

c/o streaky hemoptysis x 10days , about 5-10ml each episode

c/o loss of weight about 10kgs in 2months

c/o loss of appetite

O/E RS – B/L air entry + with decreased intensity on right side

CECT Thorax:

Multiple enlarged soft tissue density lesions with non enhancing areas largest of size 5.3x 3.4cm in subcarinal region causing narrowing of right bronchus intermedius.

Focal Collapse of rt LL anteromedial basal segment

Endobronchial biopsy:

HPE – Poorly differentiated malignancy



PET - CT:

Metabolically active mild heterogeneously enhancing soft tissue nodule in apical segment of right lower lobe – likely primary lung malignancy.

Metabolically active mediastinal lymph nodes , deep cervical and supraclavicular lymph nodes.

No evidence of metabolically active disease anywhere else in the body.

The patient was diagnosed with Stage IV adenocarcinoma Lung - (T4 N3 M1a)
