Subject: Advisory on Responsible Use of Social Media in College Uniform

It has been observed that some students are posting photographs, videos, and other content on various social media platforms while wearing the college uniform at public places and/or within the campus premises.

All students are hereby instructed to adhere to the following guidelines with immediate effect:

1. No student shall post, upload, or share any content on social media platforms while wearing the official college uniform, especially if such content:
 - Misrepresents the institution
 - Is inappropriate, unprofessional, or objectionable
 - Violates patient confidentiality or institutional ethics
2. Photography and videography within the hospital and academic areas are strictly prohibited, unless officially permitted for academic or institutional purposes.
3. The college uniform represents the dignity, discipline, and professional identity of the institution. Any misuse on public platforms will be viewed seriously.
4. Students must ensure that their online conduct reflects the ethical standards expected of future medical professionals.
5. Any violation of this directive will attract disciplinary action, which may include:
 - Written warning
 - Suspension from academic activities
 - Referral to the disciplinary committee

All Heads of Departments and faculty members are requested to disseminate this information and ensure strict compliance.

This circular is issued in the interest of maintaining the decorum, reputation, and professional integrity of the institution.
